CABIN CREW

Air cabin crew are responsible for the safety of passengers and are specially trained to deal with security and emergency situations.

Besides ensuring the safety of the aircraft, air cabin crew are also employed to ensure passengers are comfortable and that the flying experience is a pleasant one.

Air cabin crew attend to passengers' needs throughout the flight and provide a high level of customer service, serving refreshment and selling duty-free goods. They are expected to be friendly, enthusiastic and courteous at all times.

The work of air cabin crew may be stressful and demanding, but it is also a varied, interesting and rewarding role.

FLIGHT DISPATCHERS

A flight dispatcher is a person responsible for planning and monitoring the progress of a flight. In airline operations, both the pilot in command and the dispatcher are legally responsible for the safety of a flight.

A flight dispatcher has the authority to delay, divert or cancel a flight at any time, and a flight cannot be released without the signature of both the pilot in command and the flight dispatcher. This improves the safety of the system by providing a form of check and balance.

A flight dispatcher typically must be licensed by the aviation authority of a country. In order to obtain the licence, the candidate must demonstrate extensive knowledge in meteorology and aviation, similar to a level that is comparable to that of an airline transport pilot license.
